We will also look at other topical issues around the region such as nutrition, disease management, varieties and more.

Herbicide resistance is our number one issue limiting continuing profitability in cropping farming systems.

On our tours we will visit a number of farm demos highlighting resistance to herbicides, including glyphosate! We will discuss the role of fallows, break crops, pre-emergent herbicides and more. At Hillston we will also look at a demo where Basta® was used as an option for controlling glyphosate resistant ryegrass (an option in Liberty® link cotton).

We've attracted one of Australia's leading scientists to our region to steer us in the right direction to manage this growing problem.

Dr Chris Preston works for Adelaide University, specialising in the science of herbicide resistance. He also manages national GRDC projects focussing on this topic. His enthusiasm and 'farmer friendly' vocabulary make the day one not to miss!
